#### Purpose

To provide an efficient and cost effective means for teams to submit for the Compass and Promote Awards.



#### **Promote Award**

The Promote Award is given to the team that is most successful in creating a compelling video message for the public designed to change our culture and celebrate science, technology, engineering and math.



#### Promote Award cont.

#### **Guidelines for the Promote Award**

- △ Team must present a thoughtful and high-quality video which appeals to the general public.
- △ Strong production value is important, but the message and impact of the video are of greater weight for the judges.
- △ Creativity in interpreting the annually assigned theme is desired.
- △ Submissions for this award will be considered for the Inspire Award but are not required.
- △ Winning videos will be submitted to FIRST and used to promote the higher values of the FIRST Tech Challenge. Teams may win the Promote Award only once at a Championship level event and only once at a qualifying level event.
- △ Team must submit a one-minute long PSA video one full week prior to the event to be eligible for this award. Additional submissions are welcome but will not be eligible for awards.
- △ **PSA Subject for 2011-2012 Season:** I'm going to change the world ...

## **Compass Award**



The Compass Award recognizes an adult coach or mentor who has provided outstanding guidance and support for a team throughout the year. The winner of the Compass Award will be determined from candidates nominated by FTC team members, via a 40-60 second video submission, highlighting how their mentor has helped them become a champion team.

## Compass Award cont.



- △ Only one video submission per team will be considered.
- ▲ Teams may submit new or updated videos at each tournament.
- △ The video must be submitted at least one week prior to tournament day.
- △ Videos must not be longer than 60 seconds (including introduction and credits if you choose to use them).
- △ Videos must be submitted in AVI, WMV or MOV format.

  (Output in the highest resolution possible)
- △ Video presentations are confidential, and may not be made public or shared with other teams prior to the award presentation.
- △ Team must submit an Engineering Notebook.



## What is Dropbox?

- △ URL www.dropbox.com
- △ Free file transfer website
- △ 2GB online storage
- △ Access and download files from anywhere
- △ Users can make folders and content public and they can share with others via e-mail



# Suggested Dropbox workflow for Promote Award

- Teams create their Promote Video and use this naming format:
  - o "team#\_promote\_competitionname"
- △ Teams create their own dropbox.com account
- Teams install Dropbox uploader on their computer
- △ Teams create a shared folder called "Promote Award"
- △ Teams upload their video to that folder
- Teams e-mail an invite to the person managing the Promote Award at the competition.
- △ Teams also invite ftcvideoawards@usfirst.org



#### Dropbox workflow cont.

- Promote Award manager creates an account on dropbox.com
- △ Promote Award manager receives e-mail from team indicating the location of their video in dropbox.com
- △ Promote Award manager follows the link and downloads the video.



1. Each team signs up for a free, 2GB Dropbox.com account and installs the desktop uploader. They upload their video to a new "shared folder" they create in Dropbox called "Promote Award".

3. The Promote Award manager follows the link. If they have not created a Dropbox account, they will be asked to do so. Once they have signed up, they can download the team's Promote Video.

2. The team e-mails the share link to the Promote Award manager.










4. Install Dropbox on your computer by following the onscreen instructions










5. Create and share a folder (cont.)










7a. Select the "upload a new file" option





Drag-and-drop your video into the Promote Award folder


