Remote Events – likely all qualifying tournaments

All events being planned for 24 teams

November through March

Traditional– as possible Jan onward

NorCal Championship Tournament – mid April; 2-3 weeks after last QT

Overall likely to have roughly 16 qualifying tournaments

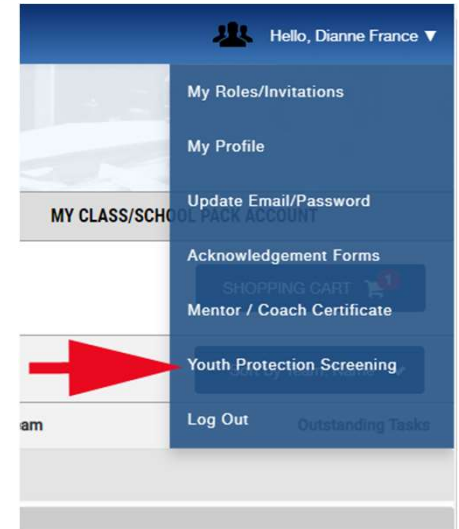

 - (2) have 2 screened coaches
 - (3) complete NorCal Survey

Qualifying Tournament Registration

- Register in a rolling schedule
 - if it's the 1st play for your team - first window
 - 2nd play teams - 2nd window (1st play can still register)
 - 3rd play teams - third window (anyone can register in this window)
- Can only register if your team qualifies for the current registration window
- November/December event registration open Oct 22nd at 7:00pm





Remote Event

Register locally like any other qualifying tournament

Managed by a Remote Event Hub – new FIRST system

Training will be available

Only accessed by “Lead Coach 1” or “Lead Coach 2”

Integrates with FTC Scoring System

Teams will upload Engineering Portfolio, team information and control award & feedback form as needed

What is a Remote Event?

Match play done remotely by the team

6 matches per event over a 6-7 day window

Self-scored

No visible scoreboard

Videos are encouraged for transparency

Judging done remotely

Virtual Award Ceremony – trophies will be mailed out

Help will be offered for teams without these resources

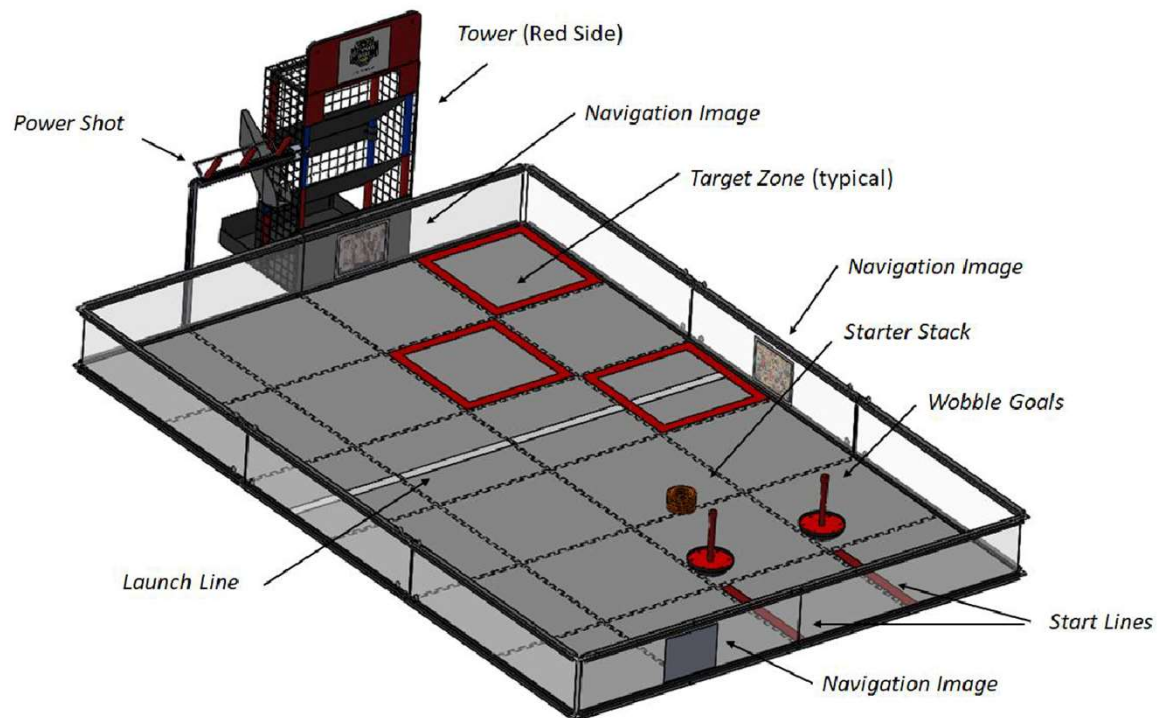




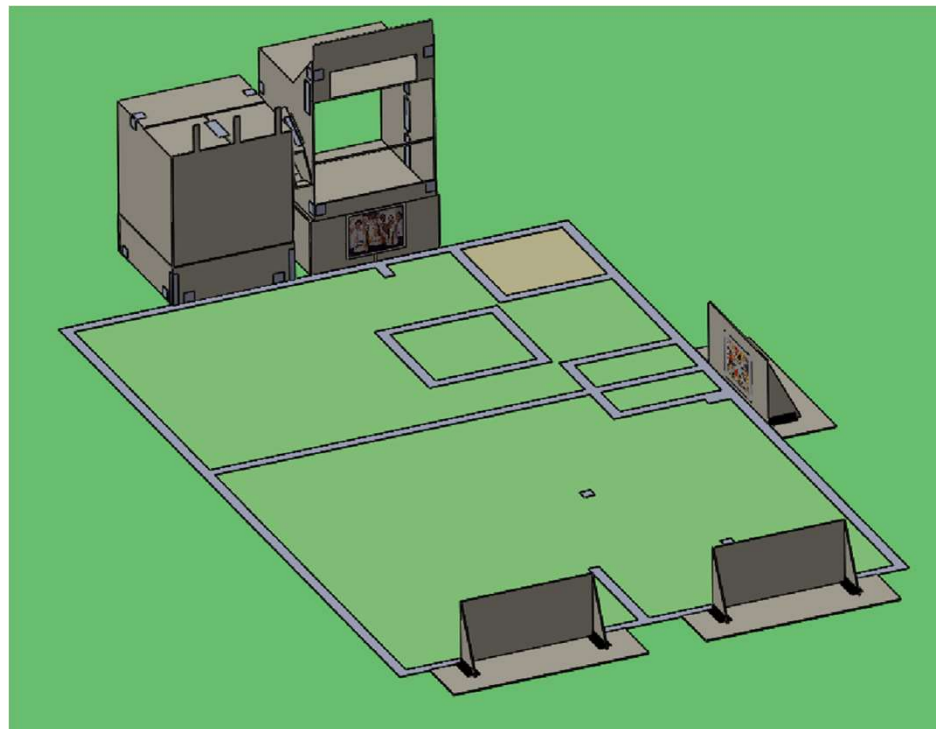

Remote Field - Minimal





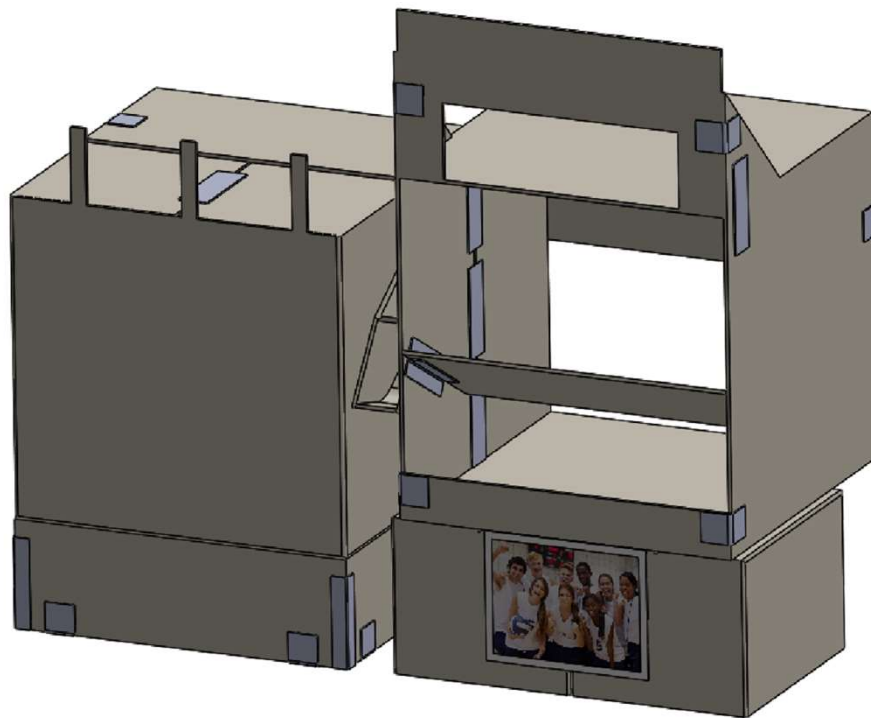

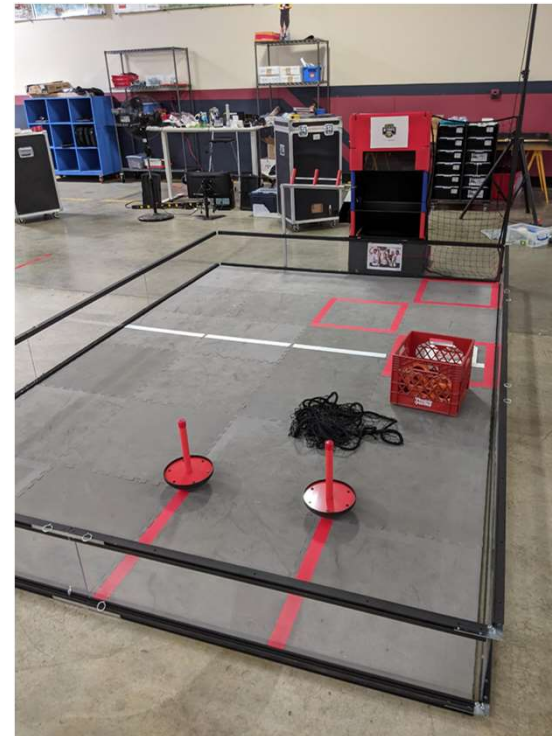

Remote Field at The Play Space

- Fields Setup & Available
 - By appointment ONLY - limited appointments per week
 - Both Red & Blue options – only one used per appointment
 - Current week's competition matches ONLY
 - Strict time limits (TBD ... 60min?)
 - Must bring own Rings and Wobble Goals
 - Limited number of people
 - Masks required
- Sanitization Protocols between uses



Remote Field At The Play Space

- Practice?
 - Exploring practice usage
 - Limits similar to Remote Event Match usages
- Would your team use it?
- Would your team be willing to pay a nominal fee?



Advancement

- Advancement order is different this year
 - Game Manual 1-Remote Event, Section 6.2
- Number of teams advancing from an event will depend on
 - Number of spots in the Championship
 - Number of Qualifying Tournaments
 - Number of teams in each QT (assuming all same size)
 - ie. if 48 in Champs, 16 qualifiers, 3 teams advance/event
- Championship size will depend on overall team enrollment
 - Likely smaller this year

Fair Play Video Tagging

- Simple Scheme
 - All tags follow basic format:
 - FTC2489-Q1-M1 (qualifier #1, match #1)
 - FTC2489-MT1-M1 (meet #1, match #1)
 - FTC2489-LT-M1 (league tournament)
 - FTC2489-RC-M1 (regional championship)
 - FTC2489-Robot (robot reveal)
- Post to searchable video service - create a channel or playlist
 - YouTube
 - others?
