Apologies for the Registration Shutdown

- More demand than we expected!
- We were caught off guard by the late surge in registration
 hard to adapt to such a surge in a short time!
- Help us in the future by responding earlier

New Qualifier Registration Process - Current Plan

- Still "Wave Based"
 - 1-2 months of events in a group/wave
 - might have only 1 group, covering ALL events! (i.e. entire season)
 - 1st play, 2nd play, etc
- Rank Your Team's Preferences for group
 - **1 to N**
- Random Sort of Teams for Period
- Teams processed one-by-one
 - registered for first available event based on ranked preference
- Teams need to be prepared to play early!





Tournament Registration Fees - Current Plan

- League Play
 - \$300 per team
- Qualifying Tournaments
 - \$175 1st play
 - \$200 2nd play
 - \$225 3rd play
- Championship Tournament
 - estimating \$350
- Above all subject to change as we work through understanding registration, the new league model and new sponsors!





Qualifying Tournament Play Limitations

- Short on Tournament Sites
 - host sites still affected by COVID restrictions
 - 2-3 host sites moved to League Play
- Currently 7 QTs in various stages of confirmation
 - Enough for 1 play per team at current growth target
 - NEED MORE
 - 7-10 more to get to 2 plays per team
- Contact us if you are:
 - a veteran team willing to host (even if you don't have a venue)
 - any team with a possible venue (even if you can't host)





League Pilot Status

- Three League Groupings Identified
 - 2 "stand-alone" ~ 16 teams each
 - Sacramento/North/East
 - Peninsula
 - 1 "metro league" ~28 teams
 - South Bay
- Invitations going out now to teams that expressed interest
- The League Interest Survey is still open
 - we will invite teams as space is available in the Leagues





Rookie Coach Workshop/Webinar

- Still being planned
- Options
 - Webinar
 - In-person Workshop
 - planning to record for those that can't join in person
- "Soon"





World Championship Status

- April 19-23, 2023 in Houston
- World Championship Growing
 - Was 160 teams in 2 divisions
 - Will be 192 teams in 4 divisions
 - more growth possible in future
 - will need MANY additional volunteers
- Our Allocation
 - 4 teams (up from 3 last year)





REV Control & Expansion Hub Status

- Limited supply
 - ~2000 in production
 - allocated to rookie teams & class packs
 - backorders start filling in late-September
 - only available through FIRST storefront
- Hoping for next order in October
 - Still short 1 chip for production to start
