


Where - Independence High School

 - o NO FOOD/DRINK










Judging

- Judging Queuers Please be persistent in queuing up teams
 - For all but one team this is Saturday night
- Schedule is on a 30 minute cycle
 - 15 minutes with judges
 - 15 minutes for the judges to finalize notes and prepare for the next team
- All initial judging interview need to complete by 9am Sunday





Why the Push for 9am??

- Opportunity to play 6 matches per team not just 5
 - More matches makes for more representative rankings
- Requires teams to be responsible about getting judging and inspection done in a timely way!

- Judging rooms will be a bit of a walk across campus
 - Be sure to remind student to leave 7-10 minutes before session to arrive on time
 - Queuers role very important Saturday night!
- Team pit areas can be setup Saturday night, but no "work/practice"
