
Where - Independence High School

Campus Map








Load In/Out

Judging

- Don't be late for your schedule time slot!
 - For most teams this is Saturday night
- Schedule is on a 30 minute cycle
 - 15 minutes with judges
 - 15 minutes for the judges to finalize notes and prepare for the next team
- All initial judging interview need to complete by 9am Sunday





Why the Push for 9am??

- Opportunity to play 6 matches per team not just 5
 - More matches makes for more representative rankings
- Requires teams to be responsible about getting judging and inspection done in a timely way!

- Judging rooms will be a bit of a walk across campus
 - Be sure to leave 7-10 minutes before session to arrive on time
 - Queuers will help remind you!
- Team pit areas can be setup Saturday night, but no "work/practice"

Important

- No Food/Drink in any of the gym floor spaces
 - Be clean in all spaces!
- In case of rain solar panels in parking lot make OK cover

- No setup of "team" practice spaces
- No running of robots on bare floors
- Safety glasses and closed-toe/closed-heel shoes!
